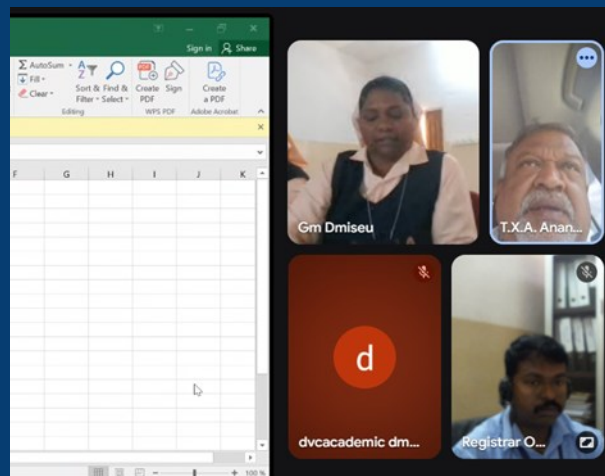

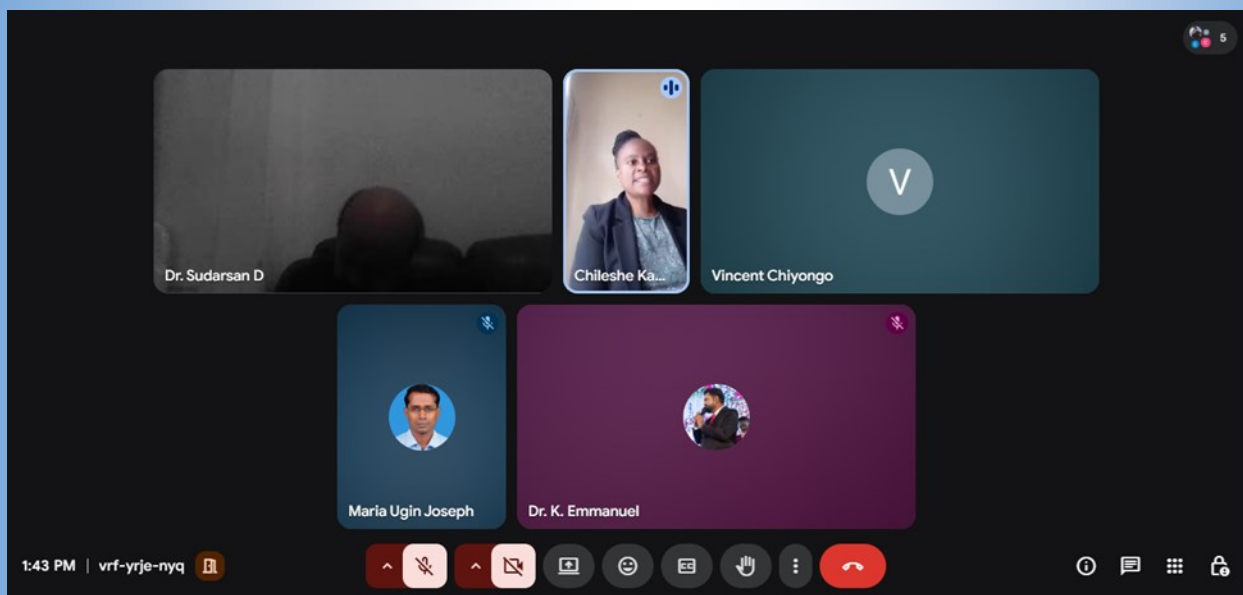


# ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS – RESEARCH, AWARDS, AND FACULTY/STUDENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS
